Key Responsibilities

- Responsible to perform or coordinate, preventative
 maintenance program, installation, troubleshooting,
 testing, servicing, repairs and operation of all
 electrical distribution panels, transformers, emergency
 generator and plant components including alarm
 systems, communication systems, TV, intercom and
 nurse call systems, electrical wiring.
- Plan repairs, projects, acquisition of new equipment and upgrades, order material needed and coordinate contractors.
- Responsible to perform or coordinate preventative maintenance program, inspections and repairs of medical (bio-medical) equipment.
- Implement improvement programs to reduce downtime hours of equipment.
- Required to read and interpret electrical drawings, schematics, blueprints, electrical code specifications, and diagrams for installation and repairs of building systems and equipment.
- Ensures all work is done according to standard practices, Canadian Electrical Code, and provincial and local building codes; maintains proper logs.

Qualifications

- Regular shifts (7.5 hours) which are typically from Monday to Friday during regular business hours.
 Flexibility is required for evening and weekend work on an occasional basis.
- Must possess a current certification of qualification as a Construction/Maintenance (309A) Electrician with Ontario provincial standing.
- Must have good knowledge of electrical principles, electrical controls, electronics, (heating and cooling systems); and relative and recent experience in the electrical trade.
- Ability to adapt to duties that may vary frequently is required.
- Shows good understanding that priorities can change quickly due to whatever is happening in the hospital.
- Able to work alone or with a team.
- Experience in medical equipment service and repair is preferred.
